- Utility bills

You are going to have to work with a professional vehicle shipping company and you will need to spend a little time preparing things for import into Greece. A professional vehicle shipping company will be able to help with a shipping quote as well as information on restrictions and weight limits for vehicle shipments. If you are visiting Greece for a short time, you can [import your car](#) for up to six months. Long term foreign residents must apply for a permit before importing a car.

Vehicle Paperwork Requirements for Customs

- Proof of vehicle insurance
- International Driver's License
- Proof of ownership
- Registration
- Residence permit
- Consular certificate
- Utility bills
- Property tax or rent receipt
- Tax returns or W2 form
- Passport
